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KRUGER NATIONAL PARK



Visit the iconic Kruger National Park on safari and spend your honeymoon in the peace and serenity of the African plains. There is something so irresistibly romantic about the African bush. Rhino Post Safari Lodge and Plains Camp (Rhino Walking Safari's Base Camp) are set in a colonial fashion with a natural African backdrop that sets the scene for an unforgettable honeymoon.

## Day 1. Rhino Post Safari Lodge Kruger National Park

Daily flights ex Johannesburg & Cape Town to Skukuza airport, from there it is a 30 min road transfer to the lodge.

Arrive at Rhino Post from 13h00 and relax before enjoying a delicious high tea at 15h30. After high tea you will depart on your evening game drive. In addition to the private wilderness concession, the drives make use of the Kruger Public Roads, particularly as the Rhino Post vehicles are allowed to utilise certain public roads for night drives well after gate closing times.

At sunset the game drive will stop for drinks while watching an African sunset, before continuing on into the night, spotting nocturnal animals. Return to the lodge at about 19h30 to freshen up before dinner.

# Day 2 Rhino Post Safari Lodge Kruger National Park

After an early morning wake-up and an invigorating cup of fresh coffee or tea with muffins in our lounge, the game drive will begin. Midway through the morning you will stop in the bush for coffee/tea/fruit juice before continuing to look for Africa's finest wildlife.

Upon returning to the lodge, enjoy a leisurely brunch. There is plenty of time afterwards to relax around the pool which overlooks the water hole, catch up on some sleep, or read some books.

After high tea you will depart again on your afternoon game drive. Return to the lodge in time to freshen up, enjoy a drink before a sumptuous dinner on the deck or in the dining room, as you recount the day's events, all the while accompanied by the night sounds of the bush.

#### Includes:

Rhino Post Safari Lodge 2 Nights' accommodation, meals, teas and coffees. 2 game drives per day

Plains Camp 3 Nights' accommodation –brunch, high tea and dinner, teas and coffees, morning walks and afternoon game activity combination, soft drinks, house wine and local beers. Return 4x4 transfers from Rhino Post.



## Day 3. Plains Camp (Rhino Walking Safaris) Kruger National Park

After enjoying your final morning game drive at Rhino Post and a delicious brunch, you will be transferred to Plains Camp in an open 4x4 game vehicle. Plains Camp is situated in the heart of the wilderness concession overlooking the spectacular Timbetene Plain and waterhole.

Built in authentic pioneer tradition, it has the serenity of a 19th century naturalists rest, nestled in an Acacia Knobthorn thicket. After settling into your tent you will enjoy high tea and a thorough briefing on the do's & don'ts of walking in the bush.

Your armed ranger will take you on a short orientation walk followed by a game drive and sundowners. After which you will return to the camp for a delicious dinner and stories around the fire.

### Day 4 Plains Camp (Rhino Walking Safaris) Kruger National Park

Another early morning wake up and morning walk will bring a whole host of new experiences and adventures. The walk lasts between 3-4 hours after which you return to the camp for a hearty breakfast.

The rest of the day is for you to relax by the plunge pool watching Africa's wild animals on the plains. After high tea you depart again for the drive and walk combination. Returning to talk about the days events and listen to the calls of the night.

## Day 5 Sleep Outs (Optional) Kruger National Park

There is an optional Sleep Out experience while at Plains Camp. Sleep Outs which is a giant treehouse with sleeping platforms elevated about 4 metres above the ground, each platform has a tent made of fabric that allows you to gaze at the stars from your sleeping bag. Guests depart for a 1-1.5 hour walk arriving at Sleep Outs n the early evening. Guests enjoy sundowners overlooking the waterhole as the guides prepare the fire and traditional South African Braai (barbeque). The guides accompany you 24/7 and are highly trained and experienced rangers.

#### Excludes:

Park Fees, transfers, gratuities, items of a personal nature, additional alcoholic drinks at Plains Camp and all drinks at Rhino Post.
